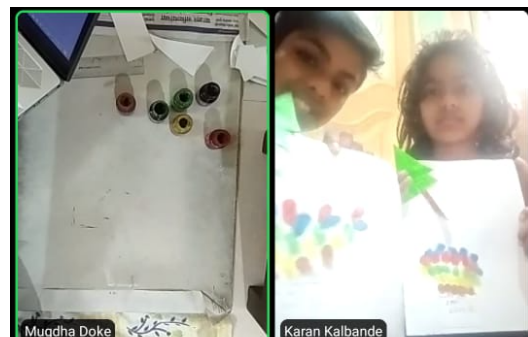
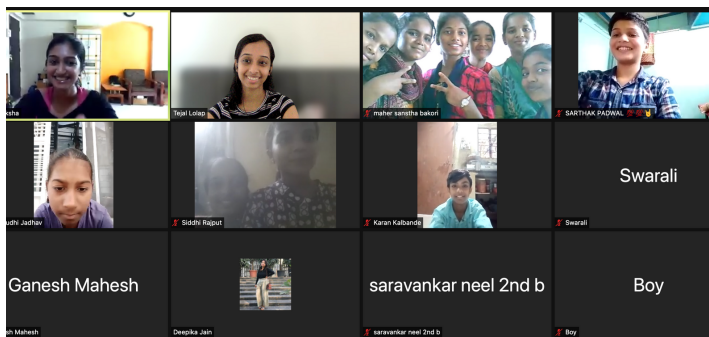


Top Updates
