A Snapshot of Our Programs

English Communication

Student age group: 5 - 17

Improve English speaking, reading, writing & listening skills in children attending low-income schools through a specially designed curriculum

Holistic Development

- Student age group: 5 17
- Promote all-round growth in under-resourced children through exposure to extracurricular areas and soft-skill development
- We also host events for students from our EC & HD programs

Empowered Communication

- Student age group: 18+
- Build employability skills and English communication confidence in adults through an 8-week program taught by expert facilitators. Modules taught: Public speaking, CV building & email writing, book & movie review, job interviews

Mentorship

- Student age group: 18+
- Enhance English communication skills in adults through 1:1 mentorship and workshops, and exposure to quality English language resources across listening, speaking, reading and writing domains



Top Updates

Change is coming!

In an endeavour to streamline our programs for children, we are are combining our existing 'English Communication' and 'Holistic Development' programs!

What this means -

- We're revamping the curriculum by meaningfully linking English topics with Holistic Development topics such as creativity, time management, etc.
- Learning English will now be more fun with activitybased components targeted at promoting all-round growth, associated with each English topic

Timeline: We're working towards launching this program in June 2022! More updates to follow.

Program Pillars














February '22 All-Volunteer Meet
